

# WARMING CENTER LOCATIONS

*Greater New Haven Coordinated Access Network (GNH CAN)*

These are the walk-in warming center locations for the 2024 to 2025 cold weather season. Dates and details differ by site. When referring a client to a site, if able, call the site prior to arriving to see if there is capacity.

## **180 Center**

**[11/15/24 to 4/15/25]** 438 East St. New Haven #203-214-8836 or #203-494-3642

Opens at 7PM and closes at 7AM daily. For Individuals ages 18+. Space is handicap accessible. It has chairs, mats, and blankets. Patrons cannot leave and return throughout the night. Lights out at 11PM and will not have new admissions after this time. Will have outside breaks between 7:00PM and 11:00PM. If symptomatic patrons will be asked to wear a mask. No pets allowed.

## **Beth-El Center**

**[11/15/24 to 3/31/2025]** 90 New Haven Ave. Milford #203-876-0747

Opens at 7PM and closes at 8AM daily. For Individuals ages 18+. Space will provide a limited number of cots and chairs. Entry begins at 7:00 pm - Please avoid lining up prior to the start time of the program. Snacks are served at 8PM and breakfast served between 6:30AM to 7:30AM. Pets are allowed. Handicap accessible.

## **Columbus House**

**[1/8/25 to 3/31/2025]** 11 Pine St. Hamden #203-562-5129

Opens at 7PM and closes at 7AM daily. **Entrance is located on George Street in the back parking lot of the building.** For Individuals ages 18+, on a first come first serve basis. Space has tables and chairs with space available to lay on the floor. Not able to leave the property and return throughout the night. Donations of food and drinks will be available. Handicap accessible.

## **Spoooner House (Valley Only)**

**[11/15/24 to 3/31/2025]** 30 Todd Rd, Shelton #203-225-0453 x107

Opens at 9PM and closes at 6:30AM daily. No new admissions past 10:30PM, except for police escorts. Provide cots to each patron. Light food provided for dinner and breakfast as well as drinks. Shower access. Once you are in there is no leaving and returning. Handicap accessible.

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### **Varick Memorial**

**[11/15/24 to 4/15/25]** 242 Dixwell Ave, New Haven #203-645-7361

Opens at 7PM and closes at 7AM daily. For individuals ages 18+. There are a few steps to enter the building. Space has tables, chairs, and cots, limited availability. Will accept new admissions throughout the night. Once there, unable to leave and return. There will be four scheduled outdoor breaks between 8:00PM and 11:00PM. Dinner and drinks will be available. Will only accept service animals.

### **Youth Continuum**

**[1/6/25 to 4/30/25]** Youth 18-24 years old 943 Grand Ave, New Haven #203-464-2722

Opens at 7PM and closes at 7AM daily. Location is on a 2nd floor (no elevator). Space has tables and chairs. Admissions will be accepted through 10:00PM, with provisions being made for late entries as needed, with a provider referral, etc. Youth cannot leave and return throughout the night. Light food and drinks will be provided, in addition to basic needs and hygiene products and referrals to case management, CAN Assessments, etc. No pets allowed.

Unsheltered or runaway minor youth should call/text to be connected to shelter services.
